Evergreen Memorial Park Cemetery is located in the city of Sumter, South Carolina, at 802 N. Guignard Drive. It was established in the mid-to-late 1950's. Although there are some grave markers with earlier death dates than the 1950's, these are for re-burials.

We surveyed this cemetery beginning on 30 October 1999, and completed the survey on 14 November 1999. As of the latter date, there were 4,015 marked graves. There are many unmarked graves, also. Since funeral home markers are not allowed at the grave sites in this cemetery, we did not try counting the unmarked graves because we were conducting a "walking" survey of only the marked graves. Where there is a double marker with only one name, it is listed as being a double marker. Some markers had full names with no dates-these are also in the listing.
